





## Implementing HIV Prevention Programs for Transgender Women: A Managers Course

*(Offered in English)*

Implementing HIV Prevention Programs for Transgender Women: A Managers Course is designed to equip managers from community-based organizations with best practices for planning and implementing HIV prevention programs and HIV care services for transgender women, including but not limited to the Transgender Women Involved in Strategies for Transformation (TWIST) intervention. This 2-day course provides tools and resources to support agencies during each of the program planning phases, from pre-implementation to implementation and maintenance.

## PROMISE for HIP

*(Offered in English)*



PROMISE for HIP is a community-level HIV/STD prevention intervention that relies on role model stories, created by and for the community and peer advocates, to reduce HIV risk behaviors and increase engagement related to the HIV continuum of care. Through lectures and skills-building activities, participants will learn and practice utilizing some of the key tools used in PROMISE for HIP during this 1-day training.

## Sin Buscar Excusas

*(Offered in English, coming soon in Spanish)*



Sin Buscar Excusas/No Excuses is a single-session, small-group, video-based behavioral intervention that aims to increase sexual safety and HIV testing and care among Hispanic/Latino gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men (MSM). During the 1-day Sin Buscar Excusas/No Excuses training, participants will gain skills in implementing the intervention in various settings, including clinics and community agencies. Group sessions last approximately 60 minutes and include three core elements.

## Sister to Sister: Take Control of Your Health (TCYH)

*(Offered in English, coming soon in Spanish)*



Sister to Sister: Take Control of Your Health (TCYH) is a one-on-one, woman-to-woman, brief 45–60-minute intervention where the provider offers their patient the knowledge and skills, they need to reduce their risk of HIV. The intervention seeks to empower women to take control of their health by choosing PrEP and/or using condoms consistently to prevent HIV. Sister to Sister: TCYH also uses CDC's new #ShesWell campaign to reinforce a variety of healthful messages. The 2-day training of facilitators course includes an eLearning module; live, instructor-led virtual training; and course evaluation.

## Social Network Strategy (SNS)

*(Offered in English and Spanish)*



Social Network Strategy (SNS) is a public health strategy based on the principle that persons within the same social network who know, trust, and share the same risks and risk behaviors for HIV, can exert influence on each other. The 1-day SNS course trains staff in an evidence-supported approach to engage and motivate a person at risk for HIV to accept a service such as HIV testing.

## Stay Connected for Your Health

*(Offered in English)*



Stay Connected for Your Health is a clinic-wide intervention designed to assist clinics in retaining patients in HIV care. The Stay Connected for Your Health training has two virtual, instructor-led training components. The half-day All Staff Training is all staff at the clinic, and the 2-day Retention Specialist Training is designed specifically for the staff who will fill the role of Retention Specialist and that person's supervisor.
