Leadership Training Institute (LTI)

LTI is a program at CAI that offers a range of capacity building programs for peers and supervisors, including:

- A Training for Supervisors, and Managers, and Directors, for those who supervise peers pursuing certification;
- A foundational health and wellness training for peers who are just beginning the peer certification process. Although this and other Foundational programs are not required for certification, they offer peers skills in self-management of chronic conditions and maintaining a professional demeanor.
